What is a Social Support Ambassador?

As a 'familiar student' (you've spent a year or more in the university), you would support newer students with settling into the hustle and bustle of university life, providing extra-curricular support. The aim of a Social Support Ambassador is to enhance the student experience outside of lectures and provide an overall balanced university experience.

If you become a social support ambassador, you will be:

- Liaising with the sabbatical officers on upcoming events and social activities across all campuses

- Enhancing student engagement with extra-curricular activities such as the various sports games and matches, SU societies and events, amongst others
