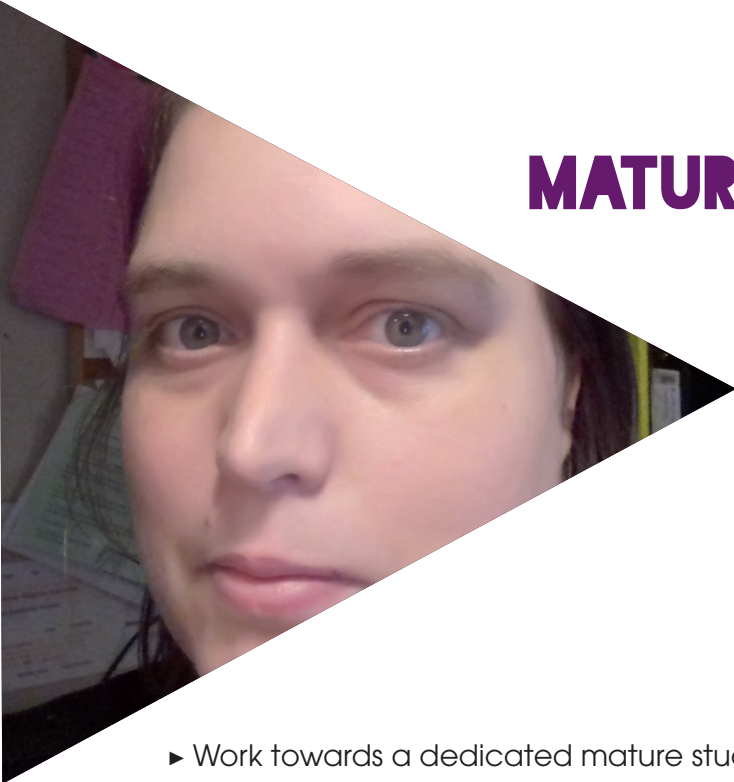

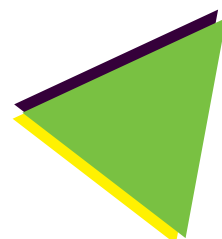


- ▶ Work towards a dedicated mature student open day so that potential students can have tailored advice.

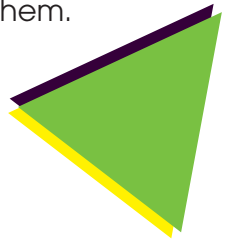
- ▶ Improve B.A.M.E attainment.

- ▶ Network with other Universities to improve the university experience for all





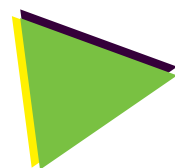
STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES REPRESENTATIVE **HENRY OBI** ENABLING US ALL
